New Travel/Entry Regulations - Republic of India

People allowed to enter to the Republic of India:

- Indian citizens and residents.
- Citizens of Nepal and Bhutan.
- Passengers that currently hold an Overseas Citizen of India (OCI) card.
- Passengers with Visa (except Tourist and Medical Visa)
- Passengers that flies from Afghanistan, Bangladesh, Bhutan, Maldives or Nepal, through India, to their origin countries.
- People with PIO cards that are currently expired, are still valid till 31/12/2021.

The requirements that must be met to enter the Republic of India are:

- Electronic Affidavit for Entering the National Territory, which is to be completed at www.newdelhiairport.in
- A negative PCR result for COVID-19, taken 72 hours before the international flight. The result has to be uploaded to www.newdelhiairport.in
- Passengers arriving from / transiting through flights originating in United Kingdom, Europe or Middle East are subject to a COVID-19 test upon arrival, at their own expense.
- Passengers arriving from Brazil, South Africa or United Kingdom are subject to a COVID-19 test upon arrival and another test on day 7 at their own expense. They must keep quarantine till the result of the last test is presented.
